## SENATE BILL NO. 170

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require school districts to adopt teacher evaluation
- 2 policies.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-43 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 Each school board shall adopt official standards, criteria, and procedures for the evaluation
- 7 of the professional performance of members of the teaching profession employed by the school
- 8 district. A copy of the school board's official evaluation policy shall be forwarded to the
- 9 Department of Education and Cultural Affairs. The school board's policy shall address the
- 10 following:
- 11 (1) The purpose of the evaluations;
- 12 (2) The frequency of the evaluations;
- 13 (3) The procedure to be used in making the evaluations;
- 14 (4) The job-specific criteria for classroom teachers, school librarians, and school
- 15 counselors;

- 1 (5) The use of the results of the evaluations;
- 2 (6) The frequency of classroom visitations; and
- 3 (7) The written evaluations, which shall be provided to the employee.
- 4 If a school board fails to adopt and file an official evaluation policy that is consistent with this
- 5 Act, the evaluation policy promulgated by the professional practices and standards commission
- 6 is the school board's policy.
