1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to exempt law enforcement officers from the requirement 2 of the use of motor vehicle lights under certain circumstances. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That chapter 32-17 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as 5 follows: 6 The requirements of § 32-17-4 do not apply to a law enforcement officer, as defined in § 23-7 3-27, while operating a motor vehicle owned, leased, or otherwise the property of the state or 8 a political subdivision, in the performance of the officer's law enforcement duties if the officer's 9 conduct is reasonable, and if the officer reasonably believes that operating the vehicle without 10 lights is necessary under the circumstances to investigate a criminal violation or suspected 11 criminal violation of state laws or rules, court orders, or municipal or county laws, ordinances, 12 or regulations. A law enforcement officer may not operate a motor vehicle without lights under 13 this section: 14 (1) At speeds greater than what is reasonable and prudent under existing weather, road, 15 and traffic conditions;
