SENATE BILL NO. 25

Introduced by: The Committee on Education at the request of the State Treasurer

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish a task force to study prepaid post-secondary
 education tuition plans and to make an appropriation therefor.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

Section 1. There is hereby created the South Dakota Post-Secondary Education Prepaid
Tuition Study Task Force. The task force shall study opportunities for the creation of prepaid
post-secondary education tuition saving plans for South Dakota students and educational
institutions and shall analyze the advantages, disadvantages, and feasibility of such plans.

8 Section 2. The task force shall be chaired by the state treasurer and shall be composed of at 9 least nine members, each appointed for the life of the task force by the state treasurer. Two 10 members shall be legislators who are not members of the same political party. Members of the 11 task force shall also include the state treasurer and at least one representative of each of the 12 following: the Bureau of Finance and Management, the Board of Regents, the Department of 13 Education and Cultural Affairs, the State Investment Council, and one or more private 14 institutions of higher learning in South Dakota and may include members selected at large. Any 15 vacancy on the task force shall be filled by an appropriate appointment by the state treasurer.



1	Section 3. The task force shall report its findings to the Governor and the Executive Board
2	of the Legislative Research Council by November 1, 1997, and at least annually thereafter. The
3	task force may report findings and conclusions or recommend legislation at any time.
4	Section 4. The members of the task force shall receive per diem and expenses as provided
5	by statute.
6	Section 5. The task force shall terminate no later than June 30, 2000.
7	Section 6. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of ten thousand
8	dollars (\$10,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the state treasurer to provide for
9	per diem, expenses, and operations of the South Dakota Post-Secondary Education Prepaid
10	Tuition Study Task Force.
11	Section 7. The state treasurer shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw
12	warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

13 Section 8. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by

14 June 30, 1998, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
