- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to remove certain restrictions on public employees and public employee organizations and to declare an emergency.

 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

 Section 1. That § 3-18-12 be repealed.

 3-18-12. Any state or national association or employee organization of public employees who
- 6 shall knowingly incite, agitate, influence, coerce, or urge a public employee to strike is guilty of
- 7 a Class 2 misdemeanor and in addition is subject to a civil fine not to exceed fifty thousand
- 8 dollars.
- 9 Section 2. That § 3-18-13 be repealed.
- 10 3-18-13. Any employee or group of employees who shall knowingly incite, agitate, influence,
- 11 coerce, or urge a public employee to strike shall be guilty of a Class 1 misdemeanor.
- Section 3. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full
- 14 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
