## SENATE BILL NO. 66

Introduced by: The Committee on Health and Human Services at the request of the Department of Human Services

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to consolidate the duties of the Governor's Advisory
- 2 Committee on Employment of Individuals with Disabilities under the Board of Vocational
- 3 Rehabilitation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 Section 1. That § 60-7-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 6 60-7-1. There The Board of Vocational Rehabilitation is hereby created designated as the
- 7 Governor's Advisory Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities and shall perform

8 the duties of the Governor's advisory committee on employment of people with disabilities,

- 9 which shall consist of fifteen or more residents of the state of South Dakota to be chosen from
- 10 representation from industry, labor, private business, veterans' organizations, private
- 11 organizations, and public agencies interested in people with disabilities. Members of the
- 12 committee shall be appointed by the Governor to serve at his pleasure without compensation.
- 13 Section 2. That § 60-7-2 be amended to read as follows:

15 promote and solicit employment opportunities for qualified physically and mentally impaired

<sup>14 60-7-2.</sup> The Governor's Advisory Committee on Employment of People with Disabilities shall

- 1 individuals <u>with disabilities</u> and conduct a public education program concerning the abilities of
- 2 people with disabilities to live productive lives independently.
- 3 Section 3. That § 60-7-3 be repealed.
- 4 <u>60-7-3. The committee shall elect from its own membership a chairman, first vice-chairman,</u>
- 5 second vice-chairman, secretary-treasurer, and three executive board members at its annual fall
- 6 meeting to serve for a two-year term or until his successor has been elected and qualified.
- 7 Section 4. That § 60-7-4 be repealed.
- 8 <u>60-7-4. The officers and executive board members mentioned in § 60-7-3 shall constitute the</u>
- 9 executive committee of the Governor's advisory committee on employment of people with
- 10 disabilities.
- 11 Section 5. That § 60-7-5 be repealed.
- 12 <u>60-7-5. The committee shall meet not less than twice annually to perform its duties. Those</u>
- 13 members in attendance shall constitute a quorum for the conduct of business.
- 14 Section 6. That § 60-7-6 be repealed.
- 15 <u>60-7-6. The committee shall establish procedures governing its internal affairs, not otherwise</u>
- 16 inconsistent with the statutes of the state of South Dakota, and keep and submit to the Governor
- 17 minutes of its meetings. The committee shall file an annual report.
