- WHEREAS, it is the goal of the Legislature to decrease the taxation of property by
- 5 approximately ten percent from current levels; and
- WHEREAS, additional property tax relief should be achieved by alternatives other than
- 7 increasing or broadening the sales and use tax; and
- 8 WHEREAS, further property tax relief could be accomplished by obtaining revenue from
- 9 corporations through a franchise tax without discouraging business investment and expansion;
- 10 and
- NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Seventy-second Legislature
- of the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that the
- 13 Governor and Legislature should appoint a special task force to study a corporate franchise tax
- and propose any legislation and ballot measures necessary to implement the tax and provide

- 2 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the task force be comprised of civic and business
- 3 leaders and current members of the Legislature; and
- 4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that one task force member who shall serve as the chair of
- 5 the task force be appointed by the Governor; and
- 6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that two task force members be appointed by each of the
- 7 following officers: the republican leader of the Senate, the democratic leader of the Senate, the
- 8 republican leader of the House of Representatives, and the democratic leader of the House of
- 9 Representatives; and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that each officer of the Legislature shall appoint one civic
- or business leader and one current member of the Legislature: and
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that task force shall report to the 1998 Legislature.
