## HOUSE BILL NO. 1025

Introduced by: The Committee on Retirement Laws at the request of the South Dakota Retirement System

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to bring the South Dakota Retirement System's annual
- benefit improvement for certain firefighters in line with the improvement for other
- 3 members.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 Section 1. That § 3-12-154 be amended to read as follows:
- 6 3-12-154. Each retired member or benefit recipient described in § 3-12-153 shall receive the
- 7 same benefit under the form of annuity provided by the City of Mitchell firemen's pension plan
- 8 as in effect on June 30, 1996, except for the improvement factor. Each benefit shall continue to
- 9 be improved on July 1, 1996 2008, and thereafter by a three and one-tenth percent simple
- 10 compounded improvement factor, as bargained and agreed to by the city of Mitchell. The
- benefits of members described in § 3-12-153 who are entitled to receive benefits from the city
- of Mitchell firemen's pension plan as of July 1, 1996, shall be paid from the fund established
- by this chapter and funded pursuant to § 3-12-156.
- 14 Section 2. That § 3-12-155 be amended to read as follows:
- 3-12-155. Upon retirement, each member described in § 3-12-153 who is a vested inactive

1 member on July 1, 1996, or an active firefighter in the employ of the city of Mitchell on July

- 2 1, 1996, shall receive the greater of:
- The member's retirement allowance calculated under this chapter; or
- 4 (2) The member's retirement allowance calculated under the city of Mitchell firemen's
- 5 pension plan based on credited service up to June 30, 1996 and compensation up to
- June 30, 1996, and utilizing the plan's benefit terms; and benefit formula and, but
- 7 applying the system's improvement factor, as specified in § 3-12-154.
- 8 In either case, the retirement allowance shall be paid from the fund established by this
- 9 chapter and funded pursuant to §§ 3-12-156 and 3-12-71.
