- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain statutes pertaining to the power of
- 2 municipalities to contract for planning and zoning services.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 11-6-3 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 11-6-3. The governing body of any municipality may contract with the board of county
- 6 commissioners for planning and zoning services to be provided by the county, and the contract
- 7 may provide that the municipality shall pay such fees as are agreed for the services performed.
- 8 Under the provisions of the contract the municipal governing body may authorize the county
- 9 planning and zoning commission, on behalf of the first or second class municipality, to exercise
- any of the powers otherwise granted to municipal planning and zoning commissions under this
- chapter and chapter 11-4. The contract between the governing body of the municipality and the
- 12 county may provide among other things for joint county-municipal planning activities, or it may
- designate the county planning commission as the planning commission for the municipality. The
- municipality may also contract with a planning agency, authority or commission, or with planning
- 15 consultants, or with other specialists for such services as it requires.

- 1 Section 2. That § 11-2-7 be amended to read as follows:
- 2 11-2-7. The governing body of any municipality may contract with the board for planning
- and zoning services to be provided by the county, and the contract may provide that the
- 4 municipality shall pay such fees as are agreed for the services performed. Under the provisions
- 5 of the contract the municipal governing body may authorize the county planning and zoning
- 6 commission, on behalf of the first or second class municipality, to exercise any of the powers
- 7 otherwise granted to municipal planning and zoning commissions under chapters 11-4 and 11-6.
