- 2 acknowledgment may be made before a magistrate.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 18-4-24 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 18-4-24. The certificate of proof or acknowledgment, if made before a magistrate, when if
- 6 used in any county other than that in which he the magistrate resides, must shall be accompanied
- 7 by a certificate under the hand and seal of the clerk of courts of the county in which the
- 8 magistrate resides, setting forth that such magistrate at the time of taking such proof or
- 9 acknowledgment was authorized to take the same such proof or acknowledgment, and that the
- clerk is acquainted with his the magistrate's handwriting and believes that the signature to the
- original certificate is genuine.
