1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain statutes regarding where proof or
2 acknowledgment may be made before a magistrate.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That § 18-4-24 be amended to read as follows:

5 18-4-24. The certificate of proof or acknowledgment, if made before a magistrate, ~~when if~~
6 used in any county other than that in which ~~he~~ the magistrate resides, ~~must~~ shall be accompanied
7 by a certificate under the hand and seal of the clerk of courts ~~of the county in which the~~
8 ~~magistrate resides~~, setting forth that such magistrate at the time of taking ~~such proof or~~
9 ~~acknowledgment~~ was authorized to take ~~the same~~ such proof or acknowledgment, and that the
10 clerk is acquainted with ~~his~~ the magistrate's handwriting and believes that the signature to the
11 original certificate is genuine.
