1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize the Banking Commission to promulgate certain 2 administrative rules regarding the mortgage lending business. 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 4 Section 1. That § 54-14-1 be amended to read as follows: 5 54-14-1. Terms as used in this chapter mean: 6 (1) "Director," the director of the Division of Banking of the State Department of 7 Commerce and Regulation; (2) 8 "Division," the Division of Banking of the State Department of Commerce and 9 Regulation; "License," the license provided by this chapter; 10 (3) 11 (4) "Licensee," the person holding a license provided by this chapter; 12 (5) "Mortgage," any interest in land created by a written instrument providing security for 13 the performance of a duty or the payment of a debt; 14 (6) "Mortgage banker," any person who, for valuable consideration, engages in the 15 business of dealing in mortgage loans including their placement and refinancing;

- 1 (7) "Mortgage loan," loans of money secured by a mortgage on real estate;
- 2 (8) "Mortgage broker," any person who acts as an intermediary between borrower and
- 3 <u>lender in securing a mortgage loan, or places loans with investors for a consideration;</u>
- 4 (9) "Commission," the State Banking Commission.
- 5 Section 2. That § 54-14-2 be amended to read as follows:
- 6 54-14-2. Any person who engages in the business of a mortgage banker or mortgage broker
- 7 shall obtain an original license to engage in such business under the terms and conditions of this
- 8 chapter, shall apply therefor under oath, on forms prescribed by the division, and shall pay an
- 9 original, nonrefundable license fee of two hundred fifty dollars. If the application is approved,
- a license shall be issued and a fee of two hundred fifty dollars shall be paid and renewed on an
- annual basis. Licenses shall be renewed annually on the first day of July. The commission shall
- establish a license fee by rules pursuant to chapter 1-26. The maximum fee for a license is two
- 13 hundred fifty dollars.
- 14 Section 3. That § 54-14-10 be amended to read as follows:
- 15 54-14-10. The director shall have the power to adopt commission may promulgate all
- necessary rules, pursuant to chapter 1-26, for the management and administration of licensees
- under this chapter, over which he it has jurisdiction as set forth in this chapter, and to regulate
- 18 the procedure and practice of the division.
