SENATE BILL NO. 140

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the requirements for selling motorcycles at certain
2 events and to define vintage motorcycles.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. That subdivision (8) of § 32-6B-5 be amended to read as follows:

5 (8) Any person may sell vintage motorcycles at an event, if the event lasts three or more
6 days and if the person registers and purchases a permit from the Department of
7 Revenue at least five days before the event. Before issuance of a permit, the applicant
8 ~~must~~ shall provide proof ~~they are~~ the applicant is a licensed dealer in ~~their~~ the
9 applicant's own state and ~~have~~ has no outstanding dealer violations. ~~The permit will~~
10 ~~only be issued if the motorcycles being sold are not franchised in this state.~~ The
11 person shall pay a fee of two hundred dollars for a ten-day temporary permit.

12 Section 2. That § 32-6B-1 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SUBDIVISION to read
13 as follows:

14 "Vintage motorcycle," any motorcycle thirty years of age or older.
