Introduced by: Senators Drake, Everist, Frederick, and Rounds and Representatives Cutler and Gabriel

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to transfer funds from the special racing revolving fund and
2 the South Dakota-bred racing fund to the Department of Social Services for domestic and
3 sexual abuse shelter programs and child care programs and to make an appropriation
4 therefor.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

6 Section 1. The Commission of Gaming on or about July 15, 1998, shall transfer one hundred
7 seventy-five thousand dollars from the special racing revolving fund and seventy-five thousand
8 dollars from the South Dakota-bred racing fund to the Department of Social Services to provide
9 grants to qualifying contractors according to the provisions of §§ 25-10-26 to 25-10-33,
10 inclusive.

11 Section 2. The Commission of Gaming on or about July 15, 1998, shall transfer seventy
12 thousand dollars from the special racing revolving fund and thirty thousand dollars from the
13 South Dakota-bred racing fund to the Department of Social Services to provide grants to
14 qualifying providers according to the provisions of §§ 28-1-60 to 28-1-63, inclusive.

1 Section 3. There is hereby appropriated the sum of three hundred fifty thousand dollars
2 (\$350,000) of other fund expenditure authority, or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the
3 Department of Social Services to make grants as provided by sections 1 and 2 of this Act.

4 Section 4. The secretary of social services shall approve vouchers and the state auditor shall
5 draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

6 Section 5. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
7 June 30, 1999, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
