1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to transfer administration of certain dams from the
2 Department of School and Public Lands to the Department of Game, Fish and Parks.

3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

4 Section 1. All dams administered by the Department of School and Public Lands which are
5 not on land granted to the state by the United States for the use of public schools, pursuant to
6 Article VIII of the State Constitution, shall be transferred to the Department of Game, Fish and
7 Parks. The department may use up to ten percent of all license fees obtained under chapter 41-6
8 to maintain and repair these dams, for the purpose of fish and wildlife management.

9 Section 2. That § 41-6-70 be repealed.

10 ~~— 41-6-70. The game, fish and parks commission shall, at the close of each license year,~~
11 ~~reimburse the various counties for services rendered in connection with the sale of licenses under~~
12 ~~this chapter in the amount of ten percent of all license fees for licenses sold by the county~~
13 ~~treasurer or his agents during such license year, and, in addition, the county treasurers shall also~~
14 ~~be reimbursed ten percent of the fees for the east river and west river prairie firearm deer licenses~~
15 ~~and the east river and west river firearm antelope licenses sold by the department of game, fish~~
16 ~~and parks for the respective counties. No reimbursement may be made for the sale of habitat~~

1 ~~stamps or waterfowl restoration stamps. All money received as such reimbursement shall be~~
2 ~~placed in the special highway fund of the county and shall be apportioned and used as provided~~
3 ~~in §§ 32-11-5 to 32-11-7, inclusive.~~
