## HOUSE BILL NO. 1277

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide transportation allowances for certain students
- 2 attending schools outside the resident school district.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That chapter 13-30 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
- 5 follows:
- 6 If any school district closes an elementary or secondary school after July 1, 1996, any student
- 7 who would otherwise have been assigned to the school that was closed is entitled to allowances
- 8 for transportation, room, and board as provided in § 13-30-1 for school attendance in a district
- 9 other than the student's resident school district if the school in the nonresident district is closer
- 10 to the student's residence than the closest school in the student's resident school district. The
- allowance for any such student shall be paid by the resident district, including cases in which the
- student is enrolled in the nonresident district pursuant to § 13-28-40. Any allowance authorized
- pursuant to this Act shall be paid for the 1998-1999 school year and for each school year
- 14 thereafter.
