## SENATE BILL NO. 30

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow parole violation and noncompliance hearings to be
- 2 conducted through telephone conferencing or interactive video conferencing.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 24-13-11 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 24-13-11. The Board of Pardons and Paroles may conduct hearings by teleconference
- 6 <u>telephone conferencing or interactive video conferencing</u> during a regularly scheduled hearing
- 7 unless the hearing concerns the revocation of the prisoner's parole or is the prisoner's initial
- 8 parole hearing pursuant to § 24-15A-39. If the hearing concerns the revocation of the prisoner's
- 9 parole or is the prisoner's initial parole hearing pursuant to § 24-15A-39, at least one member
- of the board shall be physically present with the prisoner. The board may transmit receive
- documentary evidence via facsimile machines or other electronic means of document transfer.
