SENATE BILL NO. 108

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit willful trespass on private property or on water
- 2 or ice covering private property.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 41-9-1 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 41-9-1. Except as provided in § 41-9-2, no person may fish, hunt, or trap upon any another
- 6 <u>person's</u> private land not his own or in his possession or upon any water or ice covering another
- 7 person's private land without permission from the owner or lessee of such land.
- 8 No person violating this section may be convicted of trespass if the person did not have
- 9 actual or constructive knowledge that the land was private. If the person has been told, informed,
- 10 or notified that land, including land inundated by water or covered by ice, is private, whether by
- the landowner, lessee, law enforcement officer, area resident, or any other person of probity,
- then, with regard to any future trespass, the person so informed or notified, has actual
- 13 knowledge. Constructive knowledge that land, including land inundated by water or covered by
- 14 ice, is private may be inferred from posting, fencing, the presence of crops, livestock, or
- buildings, or other physical indicia of private ownership.

A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor and is subject to § 41-9-8.
