- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to modify the funding level for the local government
- 2 transportation technology transfer special revenue fund.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 32-11-37 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 32-11-37. Prior to the apportionment required by § 32-11-35, the secretary of revenue shall
- 6 apportion three quarters one-half of one percent of the local government highway and bridge
- 7 fund up to a maximum of ninety-one thousand dollars per fiscal year to the local government
- 8 transportation technology transfer special revenue fund created in § 32-11-36. The remaining
- 9 money in the local government highway and bridge fund shall be apportioned pursuant to
- 10 § 32-11-35. The secretary of revenue shall apportion funds to the local government
- transportation technology transfer special revenue fund at the same time and in the same manner
- 12 as specified in § 32-11-35.
