- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow for the transfer of surplus property to tribal
- 2 subdivisions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 5-23-32 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 5-23-32. When If any department, institution, or office has a surplus of furniture or fixtures,
- 6 equipment, or supplies, or when if such furniture or fixtures, equipment, or supplies, have
- 7 become useless or no longer needed by such department, institution, or office, the Bureau of
- 8 Administration may transfer such surplus property to some other department, institution, or other
- 9 state agency or Indian tribe or tribal subdivision, and if such transfer cannot be made, the bureau
- 10 shall dispose of such furniture or fixtures, equipment, or supplies at private or public sale. Before
- such sale is made, such property shall be appraised by the Bureau of Administration, and the
- property may not be sold for less than ninety percent of such appraisal.
