- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to authorize additional off-sale retail liquor licenses in
- 2 certain municipalities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 35-4-4 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 35-4-4. No person, corporation, or business entity may be the holder of or have an interest
- 6 in more than three retail licenses issued under subdivision 35-4-2(3), (4), (6), or (13). However,
- 7 a person, corporation, or business entity may hold or have an interest in three additional retail
- 8 licenses issued under subdivision 35-4-2(4) if the licensee derives more than fifty percent of the
- 9 licensee's gross receipts from the sale of food at the location where the license is held. <u>In</u>
- 10 addition, any person, corporation, or business entity may hold or have an interest in additional
- retail licenses issued under subdivision 35-4-2(3) in a first class municipality if the licensee
- derives less than fifty percent of the licensee's gross receipts from the sale of alcoholic beverages
- 13 at the location where the license is held. For purposes of this section, location means one
- 14 contiguous piece of real estate on which sales are generated by the licensee.
