- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise municipal authority to license, tax, and regulate
- 2 certain transient merchants.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 9-34-7 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 9-34-7. Every Each municipality shall have power to may license, tax, and regulate transient
- 6 merchants, auctioneers, transient, bankrupt, and auction stores, and stores of like nature, gift
- 7 enterprises, and every any business or vocation of like character, except when unless carried on
- 8 by a person retailing merchandise or products of his the person's own manufacture or production,
- 9 and except. However, a municipality may license, tax, and regulate a transient merchant retailing
- 10 merchandise or products of the person's own manufacture or production at any event where
- there are two hundred fifty or more transient merchants. This section does not apply to the
- distribution of any commodity from a railroad car by a cooperative association purchased in car
- 13 lot for the personal use of its members.
