- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to permit municipalities to issue a temporary on-sale license
- 2 during certain large events.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 35-4-14.2 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 35-4-14.2. Any municipality may issue an on-sale license to be operated at a convention hall
- 6 established pursuant to chapter 9-52 or 9-53. Such license shall be issued without regard to the
- 7 population limitations established pursuant to § 35-4-11. In addition, any municipality with a
- 8 population exceeding one hundred thousand or any municipality hosting an annual event attended
- 9 by one hundred thousand or more persons may issue an on-sale license to be operated at a
- sporting event held at a publicly owned sports arena or facility that seats a minimum of one
- thousand persons. Before a license may be issued in a municipality hosting an annual event, the
- municipal finance officer shall estimate the previous year's attendance at the event and provide
- 13 the estimate to the governing body of the municipality. Any license issued pursuant to this
- section shall be issued for a period not to exceed five consecutive days and the license shall

- 1 expire at twelve midnight on the fifth day after issuance. No license may be issued, pursuant to
- 2 the provisions of this section, in a municipality which operates a license pursuant to § 35-4-14.1.
- 3 No public hearing is required for the issuance of a license pursuant to this section if the individual
- 4 applying for the license holds an on-sale alcoholic beverage license in the municipality or holds
- 5 an operating agreement for a municipal on-sale alcoholic beverage license. No person who holds
- 6 an operating agreement for a municipal license pursuant to § 35-4-14.1 may receive a license
- 7 pursuant to this section.
