SENATE BILL NO. 224

Introduced by: The Committee on Appropriations at the request of the Governor

1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to make an appropriation to help fund the memorials for
2 persons awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor and for a fiftieth anniversary ceremony
3 of the Korean War and to declare an emergency.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of one hundred thirty
6 thousand dollars (\$130,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of
7 Military and Veterans' Affairs to provide for the establishment of public commemorative
8 memorials for persons awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor and for a special ceremony
9 honoring the fiftieth anniversary of the Korean War.

10 Section 2. The secretary of the Department of Military and Veterans' Affairs shall approve
11 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

12 Section 3. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
13 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full
14 force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
