1	FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the distribution of certain sales tax revenues.
2	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
3	Section 1. That § 10-52-5 be amended to read as follows:
4	10-52-5. All moneys received and collected on behalf of a particular political subdivision by
5	the State Department of Revenue, pursuant to this chapter, shall be credited to a special
6	municipal non-ad valorem tax fund which is hereby established in the state treasury and after
7	deducting the amount of refunds made, the amounts necessary to defray the cost of collecting
8	the tax, and the administrative expenses incident thereto, except the first one percent tax levied
9	pursuant to § 10-52-2, shall be paid within thirty days after collection to the municipality entitled
10	thereto.
11	Section 2. That chapter 10-52 be amended by adding thereto a NEW SECTION to read as
12	follows:
13	The Department of Revenue shall remit the money from the first one percent levied pursuant
14	to § 10-52-2 to each municipality levying the tax based on each municipality's pro rata share of
15	population of the municipalities levying the tax as determined by the most recent data from the
