- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to establish procedures to resolve certain disagreements
- 2 regarding overhead or underground facilities crossing railroad rights-of-way.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 49-16A-100 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 49-16A-100. The public utilities commission shall make promulgate rules and regulations
- 6 pursuant to chapter 1-26 for the setting of poles on railroad right-of-way, and the stringing or
- 7 suspending of telephone, telegraph, electric, or other wires over the track of railroads. If public
- 8 convenience and necessity require that overhead or underground facilities of common carriers,
- 9 public utilities, rural water systems, or municipalities cross over or under railroad right-of-way
- 10 located outside of public grounds, streets, alleys, and highways in this state, and the owners of
- the facilities and the railroad right-of-way have failed to agree upon the terms and conditions or
- 12 compensation for the same, the commission, after notice and hearing, may prescribe reasonable
- terms, conditions, and compensation under which the crossing shall be permitted. No
- compensation may be required of any common carrier for crossing railroad right-of-way within
- public grounds, streets, alleys, and highways in this state.
