## HOUSE BILL NO. 1294

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to provide a financial incentive for school districts to
- 2 consolidate.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. If two or more school districts consolidate after July 1, 2001, the new school
- 5 district is entitled to one hundred dollars per average daily membership as defined in § 13-13-
- 6 10.1, up to a maximum of one thousand two hundred average daily membership for three years
- 7 after the first year of consolidation.
- 8 Section 2. If the consolidated school district does not consist of at least two complete school
- 9 districts as they existed prior to consolidation, the average daily membership is the average daily
- membership of the smallest school district as it existed prior to consolidation.
- 11 Section 3. The entitlement provided by this Act shall be paid by the Department of Education
- and Cultural Affairs out of any money appropriated for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 Section 4. The Department of Education and Cultural Affairs may promulgate rules pursuant
- to chapter 1-26 to implement the provisions of this Act.
