A LEGISLATIVE COMMEMORATION, Recognizing the Menno Pioneer Power Show.

WHEREAS, the Menno Pioneer Power Show to be held September 21 and 22, 2001, one-quarter mile north of Menno, South Dakota, features an Avery wooden steam thresher, a gas engine-powered wood saw, an eight-bottom antique John Deere plow pulled by a steam engine, a steam driven saw mill, a 47,000 pound Worthington engine and antique tractors and gas engines of all kinds, International Harvester tractors, equipment, and trucks, Walz District country school houses, plus many other historical buildings; and
