1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Endorsing and encouraging the Central North American
2 Trade Corridor Association.

3 WHEREAS, the Central North American Trade Corridor Association has been created as
4 a catalyst in the promotion, development, and establishment of a north/south trade corridor along
5 U.S. 83 and its connecting arteries from Canada to Mexico; and

6 WHEREAS, the Central North American Trade Corridor Association will strive to facilitate
7 trade by means of traditional methods, the use of modern technology, and the expanded use of
8 all forms of transportation; and

9 WHEREAS, the Central North American Trade Corridor has the potential to aid in the
10 development of the world's largest trading block:

11 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the House of Representatives of the Seventy-
12 sixth Legislature of the State of South Dakota, the Senate concurring therein, that the purposes
13 and establishment of the Central North American Trade Corridor Association be endorsed and
14 encouraged for its potential for stimulating the economy.
