- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to place a maximum fee for certain initial public offerings of securities.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That subsection (b) of § 47-31A-305 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 (b) Every person filing a registration statement shall pay a filing fee as follows: On the first
 6 five hundred thousand dollars of the total proposed sale price of the securities covered by such
 7 registration, the sum of one dollar per thousand dollars. All registrations over five hundred
 8 thousand dollars, the sum of five hundred dollars, plus seventy-five cents per thousand dollars
 9 of excess over five hundred thousand dollars. The minimum fee is one hundred dollars. When
 10 The maximum fee is two thousand dollars. If a registration statement is withdrawn before the
 11 effective date or a pre-effective stop order is entered under § 47-31A-306, the director shall
- 12 retain the minimum fee.
