- 4 Section 1. That § 37-22-5 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 37-22-5. The Division of Commercial Inspection and Regulation of this state is hereby
- 6 authorized and empowered to may appoint suitable and competent inspectors to aid the said
 - division in making inspections and repairs of scales under its jurisdiction, such appointments to
- 8 be made for such time as the. The division shall designate the length of any appointment. Each
- 9 person so appointed shall qualify by taking an oath of office and giving a bond to the state in the
- 10 sum of one thousand dollars conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties. Such
- inspectors inspector shall report to the division at such the time or times and in such the manner
- 12 as the said division may require.
