- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain nonresident license requirements to fish.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. That § 41-6-6 be amended to read as follows:
- 4 41-6-6. A license to fish, to the extent and in the manner permitted by a resident fishing
- 5 license, shall is not be required of persons any resident or nonresident less than sixteen years old,
- 6 when such persons less than sixteen years old are residents of this state.
- 7 Section 2. That § 41-6-53 be amended to read as follows:
- 8 41-6-53. A nonresident or visitor's license shall may be granted under \\$\frac{\xi}{2}\frac{41-6-16}{41-6-48},
- 9 inclusive, this chapter only to a person whose residence is not such as to qualify him the person
- 10 for a resident license; provided that a nonresident under sixteen years of age shall not be required
- to purchase a license to fish if such nonresident is fishing with a parent or guardian who has a
- 12 license and provided that all fish taken by such nonresident under sixteen years of age shall be
- counted as a part of the string limit of the parent or guardian with whom he is fishing.
- 14 Section 3. That § 41-6-37.1 be amended to read as follows:
- 15 41-6-37.1. A nonresident family fishing license entitles a nonresident licensee and the

- 1 licensee's immediate family, to all the privileges of resident fishing licenses. The fee and daily and
- 2 possession limit for a nonresident family fishing license shall be set by rules promulgated by the
- 3 Game, Fish and Parks Commission pursuant to chapter 1-26. The license shall describe the
- 4 licensee and shall designate the licensee's place of residence and post office address. For
- 5 purposes of this section, the term, immediate family, means the licensee, and the licensee's
- 6 spouse, and the licensee's children under the age of sixteen.
