- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal certain provisions related to the practice of
- 2 medicine or osteopathy in South Dakota while located outside of the state.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 36-4-41 be repealed.
- 5 36-4-41. Any nonresident physician or osteopath who, while located outside this state,
- 6 provides diagnostic or treatment services through electronic means to a person located in this
- 7 state under a contract with a health care provider licensed under Title 36, a clinic located in this
- 8 state that provides health services, or a health care facility licensed under chapter 34-12, is
- 9 engaged in the practice of medicine or osteopathy in this state. No nonresident physician or
- 10 osteopath who, while located outside this state, consults on an irregular basis with a licensee
- 11 under this chapter who is located in this state, is engaged in the practice of medicine or
- 12 osteopathy in this state.
