- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to require certain disclosures if selling certain implements,
- 2 machinery, equipment, or vehicles with hour meters.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. No person may knowingly sell or offer for sale any agricultural implement, farm
- 5 tractor, farm machinery, farm equipment, construction machinery, construction equipment,
- 6 motor vehicle, or recreational vehicle that has installed in it an hour meter that has been removed
- 7 or altered without disclosing the removal or alteration to the buyer or noting such on the sales
- 8 contract. A violation of this section is a Class 2 misdemeanor if the value of the property is two
- 9 hundred dollars or less. If the value of the property is more than two hundred dollars, a violation
- of this section is a Class 4 felony.
