- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise certain penalties relating to the sex offender
- 2 registry.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 22-22-36 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 22-22-36. Any person required to register pursuant to §§ 22-22-30 to 22-22-39, inclusive,
- 6 who moves to a different residence address shall inform the law enforcement agency with whom
- 7 the person last registered of the new address, in writing, within ten days. The law enforcement
- 8 agency shall, within three days of receipt, forward the information to the Division of Criminal
- 9 Investigation and to the law enforcement agency having jurisdiction of the new residence. A
- violation of this section is a Class 1 misdemeanor. Any second or subsequent violation is a Class
- 11 <u>6 felony.</u>
- 12 Section 2. That § 22-22-37 be amended to read as follows:
- 22-22-37. Any person required to register pursuant to §§ 22-22-30 to 22-22-39, inclusive,

- shall annually register with the local law enforcement agency having jurisdiction of the person's
- 2 residence verifying the information given pursuant to § 22-22-32. A violation of this section is
- a Class 1 misdemeanor. Any third second or subsequent violation of this section is a Class 6
- 4 felony.
