- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to allow persons to provide certain skin peels without a
- 2 cosmetology license.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 36-15-2 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 36-15-2. Any person, who for compensation, a fee, or any valuable consideration, engages
- 6 in any of the following practices or arts is engaged in the practice of cosmetology: dressing,
- 7 curling, waving, permanent waving, cleaning, cutting, singeing, bleaching, setting, fitting,
- 8 coloring, or similar work upon the hair or wigs of any person by any means, or who, with hands,
- 9 mechanical or electrical apparatus, or any other appliances, or by use of cosmetic preparations
- 10 or antiseptics, engages in the practice or art of massaging, cleansing, manipulating, or performing
- 11 similar services upon the scalp, face, neck, arms, bust, or shoulders, manicuring the nails, or
- 12 removing superfluous hair about the body of any person. Any person practicing cosmetology
- 13 shall be licensed under this title, while practicing within the scope of that person's license. The
- 14 following does not constitute the practice of cosmetology:
- 15 (1) Any person practicing permanent removal of hair by the use of a galvanic or

11		<u>(a)</u>	The person has received and maintains documentation of instruction in the
12			procedure from the product or appliance dealer; and
13		<u>(b)</u>	The person does not represent himself or herself as a cosmetologist or provide
14			any other cosmetology services.
