- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to appropriate money to certain school districts.
- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 3 Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of seventy thousand
- 4 dollars (\$70,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, to the Department of Education and
- 5 Cultural Affairs to provide additional state aid to school districts that had state aid to education
- 6 reduced as a result of the use of one year's opt out revenue as opposed to multiple year's opt out
- 7 revenue in determination of the amount of state aid reduction pursuant to § 13-13-73.2.
- 8 Section 2. The Secretary of the Department of Education and Cultural Affairs shall approve
- 9 vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.
- Section 3. Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated by
- June 30, 2003, shall revert in accordance with § 4-8-21.
