SENATE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 8

1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION, Designating "Yesterday's Tomorrows" in the city of Hill
2 City.

3 WHEREAS, South Dakota has been and continues to be home to any number of industrious
4 and innovative people who have thought about our state's future; and

5 WHEREAS, the Smithsonian Institution's "Museum on Main Street" program offers a
6 portable exhibition that looks at finding the future in the media, the design of homes, methods
7 of transportation, and community planning; and

8 WHEREAS, the South Dakota Humanities Council selected seven South Dakota
9 communities to host the exhibition in 2002; and

10 WHEREAS, each of these communities will examine and celebrate the ways in which their
11 residents over the years have envisioned the future through auxiliary displays and events during
12 their hosting which will involve countless numbers of visitors and residents; and

13 WHEREAS, the city of Hill City is one of those communities on the tour:

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Senate of the Seventy-seventh Legislature
15 of the State of South Dakota, the House of Representatives concurring therein, that July 22 -
