AMENDMENT 1139I FOR THE HOUSE BILL

1 An Act to require that assisted living facilities create and post visitation policies.

2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

3 **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

4	34-12-67. Assisted living facilityResidentVisitation rights.
5	Each resident of an assisted living facility has a right to receive visitors of the
6	resident's own choosing, at the time of the resident's own choosing, provided the visitation
7	does not impose upon the rights of another resident.
8	In addition to those persons granted access to a resident in accordance with their
9	official capacities, a facility must provide access to any resident by:
10	(1) A member of the resident's immediate family and other relatives of the resident,
11	subject to reasonable clinical and safety restrictions and the resident's right to deny
12	or withdraw consent;
13	(2) Any other person visiting with the consent of the resident, subject to reasonable
14	clinical and safety restrictions and the resident's right to deny or withdraw consent;
15	and
16	(3) Any person providing health, social, legal, or other services to the resident, subject
17	to reasonable clinical and safety restrictions and the resident's right to deny or
18	withdraw consent.
19	Section 2. That a NEW SECTION be added:
20	34-12-68. Visitation policies and proceduresLimitations and restrictions
21	Notice.
22	An assisted living facility shall post on its website, if one exists, and in a
23	conspicuous place within the facility, all policies and procedures pertaining to the visitation
24	rights set forth in § 34-12-67. The facility shall, prior to the signing of an occupancy

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1	contract with a resident and at least annually thereafter, provide electronic copies of the
2	visitation policies and procedures to the resident and the resident's designated family
3	members and shall provide printed copies upon request.
4	If in accordance with federal or state laws, or if in accordance with best clinical
5	practices during a health emergency, the visitation policies and procedures must be limited
6	or restricted, the facility shall inform each resident and designated family members and
7	shall provide electronic or, if requested, printed notices regarding the limitations and
8	restrictions, the reason and rationale for such, and the period of time that the limitations
9	and restrictions are to remain in effect. The facility shall also post such information on its
10	website, if one exists.
11	Any limitations and restrictions instituted in accordance with this section must be
12	reviewed at least every thirty days. The facility shall provide notice of the review to
13	residents and designated family members, encourage the submission of written and oral
14	comments, and give due consideration to the submissions.
15	If after the required review the facility determines that the limitations or
16	restrictions are to be continued, the facility shall post notice of the continuation on the
17	facility's website, if one exists, and in a conspicuous place within the facility. The notice
18	must include:
19	(1) The citation of the federal or state law being implemented; or
20	(2) A link to evidence-based research indicating that the continuation is clinically
21	necessary for the health and safety of the residents.
22	A printed copy of the applicable laws or evidence-based research must be provided
23	upon request.

26	During a health emergency, each facility shall post on its website, if one exists, a
27	link to the most recent guidance documents provided from or through the Department of
28	Health and pertaining to the imposition of restrictions or limitations on visitation and the
29	conditions under which such restrictions or limitations may be reduced or removed.
