3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:	
4	Section 1. That § 23A-3-27 be AMENDED:	
5		23A-3-27. An arrested person may apply to the court that would have jurisdiction
6	over the crime for which the person was arrested, for entry of an order expunging the	
7	record of the arrest:	
8	(1)	After one year from the date of any arrest, if no accusatory instrument was filed;
9	(2)	After one year from the date <u>At any time after</u> the prosecuting attorney formally
10		dismisses the entire criminal case on the record; or
11	(3)	At any time after an acquittal- <u>; or</u>
12	<u>(4)</u>	Within one year from the date the prosecuting attorney formally dismisses the
13		entire criminal case on the record upon a showing of good cause compelling
14		necessity.
15	Section	2. Whereas, this Act is necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace
16	health, or safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in full force	
17	and effect from and after its passage and approval.
