

## 2022 South Dakota Legislature

**Senate Bill 198****AMENDMENT 198G FOR THE HOUSE STATE AFFAIRS  
ENGROSSED BILL**

1 **An Act to establish an interim ~~juvenile continuum of care~~ committee regarding**  
2 **~~alternatives for placement of juvenile offenders~~ regarding alternative**  
3 **programming for juvenile offenders-.**

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

5 **Section 1.** An interim juvenile placement-continuum of care committee is established to  
6 consider and develop alternatives for placement-community based alternative programing  
7 that best meets to best fit the needs of the identified juveniles juvenile or juvenile offenders  
8 offender within-the their community, develop findings, report on the findings, and recommend  
9 any necessary legislation report the committee's findings. The speaker shall appoint five  
10 members of the House of Representatives and three members of the public, at least two with  
11 involvement in public education. The president pro tempore shall appoint five members of the  
12 Senate and three members of the public, at least two with involvement in public education.  
13 The Governor shall appoint eight individuals.

14 The committee must consist of:

- 15 (1) Four members of the House of Representatives, appointed by the speaker of the  
16 House of Representatives;  
17 (2) Four members of the Senate, appointed by the president pro tempore of the  
18 Senate;  
19 (3) Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the speaker of the  
20 House of Representatives;  
21 (4) Two administrators employed by school districts, appointed by the president pro  
22 tempore of the Senate;  
23 (5) One mental health professional employed in the private sector, appointed by the  
24 speaker of the House of Representatives;  
25 (6) One mental health professional employed in the private sector, appointed by the  
26 president pro tempore of the Senate;

1     (7) One addiction and prevention professional who is employed in the private sector  
2     and provides services primarily to juveniles, appointed by the speaker of the House  
3     of Representatives;

4     (8) One addiction and prevention professional who is employed in the private sector  
5     and provides services primarily to juveniles, appointed by the president pro  
6     tempore of the Senate;

7     (9) One person representing law enforcement, appointed by the speaker of the House  
8     of Representatives;

9     (10) One person representing law enforcement, appointed by the president pro tempore  
10    of the Senate; and

11    (9) Two persons representing the South Dakota Unified Judicial System, appointed by  
12    the Chief Justice of the South Dakota Supreme Court.

13           If there is a vacancy on the committee, the vacancy may be filled in the same  
14    manner as the original appointment.

15           The committee shall be under the supervision of the Executive Board of the  
16    Legislative Research Council and staffed and funded as an interim legislative committee.

17           The committee shall deliver its report and recommended legislation to the  
18    Legislature by January 1, 2023.
