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- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA: 2

3	Section .	I. That § 58-1-27 be AMENDED:			
4		58-1-27. Terms used in §§ 58-1-27 to 58-1-39, inclusive, mean:			
5	(1)	"Delivered by electronic means,":			
6		(a) Delivery to an electronic mail address at which a party has consented to			
7		receive notices or documents; or			
8		(b) Posting on an electronic network or site accessible via the internet, mobile			
9		application, computer, mobile device, tablet, or any other electronic device,			
10		together with separate notice to a party directed to the electronic mail			
11		address at which the party consents to receive notice of the posting;			
12	(2)	"Party," any recipient of any notice or document required as part of an insurance			
13		transaction, including an applicant, an insured, a policyholder, or an annuity			
14		contract holder.			
15		"Covered employee," an individual participating in a group health plan who is			
16		entitled to notices and documents and who is an employee of the sponsor or			
17		policyholder of the group health plan;			
18	(2)	"Covered person," an individual participating in a group health plan who is entitled			
19		to notices and documents;			
20	<u>(3)</u>	"Delivered by electronic means:"			
21		(a) Delivery to an electronic mail address at which a party has consented to			
22		receive notices or documents; or			
23		(b) Posting on an electronic network or site accessible via the internet, mobile			
24		application, computer, mobile device, tablet, or any other electronic device,			
25		together with separate notice to a party directed to the electronic mail			
26		address at which the party consents to receive notice of the posting:

1	<u>(4)</u>	"Party," any recipient of any notice or document required as part of an insurance
2		transaction, including an applicant, a covered employee, a covered person, ar
3		insured, a policyholder, or an annuity contract holder; and
4	<u>(5)</u>	"Smart device," an electronic device that combines a cell phone with a hand-held
5		computer and that offers internet access and text or electronic mail capabilities.
6	Section 2	2. That chapter 58-1 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
7		Notwithstanding § 58-1-30, a sponsor or policyholder of a group health plan may
8	conse	nt to notices and documents delivered by electronic means, unless there is a federa
9	<u>requir</u>	ement for a specific mode of delivery, on behalf of the sponsor or policyholder's
10	covere	ed employees and covered persons.
11	Section 3	3. That chapter 58-1 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
12		For consent to be effective under section 2 of this Act, the sponsor or policyholder
13	must:	
14	(1)	Assign each covered employee for whom consent is being given an electronic mai
15		address for employment-related purposes at which the employee may receive or
16		access notifications regarding posted notices and documents delivered by

electronic means or require each employee for whom consent is being given to provide the sponsor or policyholder with an electronic mail address or a smart device number at which the employee may receive or access notifications regarding posted notices and documents delivered by electronic means;

- (2) Require each covered person, or a covered employee on behalf of a covered person, to provide the sponsor or policyholder with an electronic mail address or a smart device number at which the person may receive or access notifications regarding notices and documents delivered by electronic means;
- (3) Provide a notification in paper form, containing the elements described in section 4 of this Act, to each covered employee and covered person for whom consent is being given prior to delivery by electronic means of notices and documents; and
- (4) Provide notice, in the manner described in section 5 of this Act, to each impacted covered employee and covered person, at the electronic mail address or smart device number designated pursuant to subdivision (2), prior to each time a notice or document is posted on an internet site.

Section 4. That chapter 58-1 be amended with a NEW SECTION:

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1		The paper form notification, as described in section 3 of this Act, must:
2	(1)	Notify the covered employee or covered person that notices and documents for the
3		group health plan will be posted to an internet site to which the covered employee
4		or covered person will have reasonable access;
5	<u>(2)</u>	Confirm the electronic mail address or smart device number to which notifications
6		regarding notice and documents will be delivered by electronic means to the
7		covered employee or person;
8	<u>(3)</u>	Provide instructions for accessing notices or documents on the internet site;
9	<u>(4)</u>	Provide the time period during which a specific type of notice or document delivered
10		by electronic means will remain accessible;
11	<u>(5)</u>	Advise the covered employee or covered person that a paper form of a notice or
12		document may be requested free of charge and of the process to request a paper
13		form;
14	<u>(6)</u>	Advise the covered employee or covered person of the right to opt out of delivery
15		by electronic means and the process to exercise that right free of charge; and
16	<u>(7)</u>	Notify the covered employee or covered person of the hardware or software
17		requirements needed to access or retain a notice or document from an internet
18		site.
19	Section !	5. That chapter 58-1 be amended with a NEW SECTION:
20		The notice, as described in section 3 of this Act, may be delivered by electronic
21	mean	s to the covered employee's or covered person's designated electronic mail address
22	or sm	art device number and must contain:
23	(1)	A prominent statement that important information regarding the group health plan
24		has been posted on the internet site;
25	<u>(2)</u>	The name of or a description of the notice or document;
26	<u>(3)</u>	The internet site address or a hyperlink at which the notice or document may be
27		accessed;
28	<u>(4)</u>	A statement of the recipient's right to request the notice or document in paper

form at no charge and the process to exercise that right;

to receive documents in paper form free of charge;

A statement of the recipient's right to opt out of delivery by electronic means and

The time period during which the notice or document will remain accessible on the

A telephone number for the insurer or the group health plan administrator.
