## AMENDMENT 59A FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

2	support career and technical education infrastructure projects, and to declare

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
5	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$1 to the
6	Department of Education, for the purpose of providing grants to school districts for the
7	construction, addition, and equipping of new or existing area career centers.
8	<b>Section 2.</b> The Department of Education shall consider applications and award grants. The department shall give preference to an applicant that:
10	(1) Collaborates with another school district in operating an existing area career
11	center, or intends to collaborate with other school districts by establishing a new
12	area career center;
13	(2) Promotes, or intends to promote, postsecondary education and workforce training
14	education in conjunction with secondary education; or
15	(3) Identifies sufficient future local sources of funding for ongoing operating and
16	maintenance costs associated with a new or expanded area career center.
17	The Department of Education may only award a grant to a school district in an amount
18	equal to, or less than, the amount of matching monies that the school district has secured
19	from local sources on a dollar-for-dollar basis for the project.
20	Section 3. The Department of Education shall accept applications for grants provided by this
21	Act from July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024.
22	Section 4. The secretary of the Department of Education shall approve vouchers and the

state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.

An Act to make an appropriation to the Department of Education for grants to

- 1 **Section 5.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 2 revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.
- 3 **Section 6.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 4 <u>existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in</u>
- 5 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
