4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
5	Section 1. There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$5 \$5,000,000 to
6	the Department of Education, for the purpose of providing grants to school districts or
7	multidistricts for the construction, addition, and equipping of equipment for new or existing
8	area career-centers and technical education programs.
9	Section 2. The Department of Education shall consider applications and award grants. To be
LO	eligible for a grant, a school district must partner, or intend to partner, with another school
l1	district or multidistrict to offer the applicable career and technical education program. The
L2	department shall give preference to an applicant a school district or multidistrict that:
L3	(1) Collaborates with another school district or multidistrict in operating an existing
L4 _	area career center, or intends to collaborate with other school districts or
L5	multidistricts by establishing a new area career center;
L6	(2)(1) Promotes, or intends to promote, postsecondary education and workforce training
L7	education in conjunction with secondary education; or
18	(3)(2) Identifies sufficient future local sources of funding for ongoing operating and
L9	maintenance costs associated with a the new or expanded area existing career
20	center and technical education program.
21	The Department of Education may only award a grant to a school district or
22	multidistrict in an amount equal to, or less than, the amount of matching monies that the
23	school district or multidistrict has secured from local sources on a dollar-for-dollar basis for
24	the project career and technical education program.

- 1 **Section 3.** The Department of Education shall accept applications for grants provided by this
- 2 Act no later than June 30, 2024.
- 3 **Section 4.** The secretary of the Department of Education shall approve vouchers and the
- 4 <u>state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized by this Act.</u>
- 5 **Section 5.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 6 <u>revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 7 **Section 6.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 8 <u>existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in</u>
- 9 <u>full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.</u>
