- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 5 **Section 1.** There is hereby appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$7,000,000 to the
- 6 <u>South Dakota Department of Public Safety, Office of Homeland Security, Office of Attorney</u>
- 7 General, for purposes of creating a local government cybersecurity services initiative for
- 8 <u>counties and municipalities throughout the State of South Dakota.</u>
- 9 **Section 2.** The funds appropriated in section 1 of this Act must be used exclusively to expand
- 10 and improve cybersecurity for local governments counties and municipalities in the State of
- 11 South Dakota, via any infrastructure and technology that can protect the information
- 12 technology assets of local governments counties and municipalities in South Dakota, and for
- administrative costs necessary for expending these dollars efficiently and effectively.
- 14 **Section 3.** Funds must be disbursed according to the specific needs of the project and in such
- 15 <u>a way that best advances the cybersecurity needs of the local governments counties and</u>
- 16 municipalities to be served.
- 17 **Section 4.** The South Dakota Department of Public Safety Office of the Attorney General shall
- 18 approve vouchers and the state auditor shall draw warrants to pay expenditures authorized
- 19 by this Act
- 20 **Section 5.** Any amounts appropriated in this Act not lawfully expended or obligated shall
- 21 <u>revert in accordance with the procedures prescribed in chapter 4-8.</u>
- 22 **Section 6.** Whereas, this Act is necessary for the support of the state government and its
- 23 existing public institutions, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, and this Act shall be in
- 24 full force and effect from and after its passage and approval.
