- 2 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- **Section 1.** That a NEW SECTION be added:

4	34-20A-114. Pain management—Non-opioid alternatives—Exceptions.
5	Before a health care provider, acting within the scope of the provider's practice,
6	may prescribe an opioid for the purpose of mitigating or alleviating a patient's pain, the
7	provider shall recommend a non-opioid medication or an alternative treatment for pain
8	management. For purposes of this section alternative treatments include acupuncture,
9	chiropractic services, massage therapy, occupational therapy, physical therapy, and
10	participation in a pain management program.
11	The restriction set forth in this section does not apply:
12	(1) To a provider who, using sound medical judgment, determines and documents in
13	the patient's medical file that:
14	(a) Following or necessitated by a major physical trauma, illness, a surgical or
15	other medical procedure, or a dental procedure, the patient's risk of adverse
16	effects from pain outweighs the risk of opioid usage; or
17	(b) The patient would receive the greatest benefit from a course of treatment
18	that includes an opioid prescription, while simultaneously pursuing
19	alternative treatments for pain management; or
20	(2) In the case of a patient who is receiving:
21	(a) Treatment for cancer;
22	(b) Palliative care;
23	(c) Hospice care; or
24	(d) Treatment for an opioid use disorder.
