## Senate Bill 55

AMENDMENT 55D FOR THE INTRODUCED BILL

1An Act to require the Board of Regents to prepare a plan providing for the shared2administration of South Dakota School of Mines and Technology and Black3Hills State University assemble a task force to study the possibility of shared4administration among the institutions of higher education under the board's5authority.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:

7 Section 1. The Board of Regents shall prepare a plan to provide for assemble a task force

8 consisting of at least eleven members to examine the possible program and administrative

9 efficiencies and cost effectiveness that may be achieved through the shared administration of

10 the South Dakota School of Mines and Technology-and, Black Hills State University, Dakota

11 <u>State University</u>, Northern State University, South Dakota State University, and the University

12 of South Dakota. All expenses incurred in carrying out the work of the task force shall be paid

13 <u>out of funds appropriated or otherwise provided to the board.</u>

- 14 The board shall present the plan findings of the task force to the Governor and to the
- 15 <u>Executive Board of the Legislative Research Council no later than November 15, 2021<del>2020</del>.</u>
- 16 Section 2. The plan shall include:
- 17 (1) The timeline in which the transition to shared administrative services will take place;
- 18 (2) The specific administrative services that will be combined;
- 19 (3) The projected reduction in workforce that will occur and how that reduction will be
- 20 <u>achieved;</u>
- 21 (4) The projected short-term costs associated with the transition;

1	(5) The long-term measurable cost savings and financial gains projected to be achieved
2	through shared administrative services;
3	(6) The educational enhancements and any other benefits that are likely at each of the
4	institutions based on the projected long-term measurable cost savings and financial gains;
5	(7) Any impact the shared administration will have on existing facilities at either of the
6	institutions; and
7	(8) The efforts that will be undertaken to ensure that only administrative services of the two
8	institutions are shared and that the history, heritage, mission, traditions, educationa
9	offerings, athletic programs, foundation, alumni association, and every other aspect of each
10	individual_institution is maintained.
11	Section 2. The task force examination shall include the following:
12	(1) The possible combining of administration at all levels of operation within ar
13	institution;
14	(2) The possible combining of operations and functions across multiple institutions;
15	(3) The possible combining of the administration of programs across multiple
16	institutions;
17	(4) A review of the duplication of program offerings;
18	(5) A review of the academic majors with low enrollments and low numbers of
19	<u>graduates;</u>
20	(6) A review of functions outside the core missions of teaching, learning, and research;
21	(7) A review of the operations and functions provided as an efficiency through the
22	central office of the Board of Regents;
23	(8) A review of the viability of the university centers; and
24	(9) Any other possible cost-effective measures the task force determines are worthy
25	of examination.
