## HOUSE BILL NO. 1024

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to repeal the requirement for school districts to have certain
- 2 teaching certificates on file.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 13-43-5 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 13-43-5. A teacher may sign a contract only upon exhibition of a valid certificate to teach
- 6 the courses and grades in the school contemplated under the said contract and to qualify such
- 7 the school for accreditation. A person shall be is eligible to sign a contract if he the person is
- 8 completing academic training which would qualify him the person for issuance or renewal of
- 9 a teaching certificate. However, if a certificate is not issued prior to the time for performance
- of the contract, such the contract shall thereafter be is thereafter void. Such certificate or a copy
- 11 thereof shall be filed in the administrative office of the school district prior Prior to making
- 12 payment under the contract, the validity of the certificate shall be verified through the
- 13 Department of Education's public online certification database.
