10		in one United States state, or a United States territory or possession, and terminates	
11		in a different United States state or a United States territory or possession;	
12	(3)	"International telecommunications service," a telecommunications service that	
13		originates or terminates in the United States and terminates or originates outside the	
14		United States, respectively. United States includes the District of Columbia or a	
15		United States territory or possession;
