## HOUSE BILL NO. 1182

- 1 FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to revise the petition requirements for the formation of an
- 2 ambulance district.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. That § 34-11A-2 be amended to read as follows:
- 5 34-11A-2. Any municipality located within the area may be included in the ambulance
- 6 district if <u>at least</u> twenty percent of the <del>landowners within the municipality who are also <u>number</u></del>
- 7 of registered voters within the municipality voting in the last gubernatorial election sign a
- 8 separate petition from that municipality, or if the governing body of the municipality establishes
- 9 intent by passing a resolution so indicating.
- Section 2. That § 34-11A-4 be amended to read as follows:
- 11 34-11A-4. Upon the filing of petition in the office of the county auditor, the county auditor
- shall determine and certify that the petition has been signed by the number of voters as specified
- 13 in § 6-16-2 at least twenty percent of the number of registered voters voting in the last
- 14 gubernatorial election within the proposed district. If the petition contains sufficient names, the
- 15 county auditor shall designate a time and place for the petition or resolution of the county
