- FOR AN ACT ENTITLED, An Act to prohibit certain forms of compensation for persons
- 2 circulating petitions.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA:
- 4 Section 1. No person may receive any wages, reward, or compensation for circulating any
- 5 petition for any initiated measure or referendum based on the number of signatures obtained by
- 6 the circulator on the petition. Nothing in this section prohibits any person from being employed
- 7 on an hourly or salaried basis to circulate such petitions. A violation of this section is a Class
- 8 2 misdemeanor.
- 9 Section 2. No person may employ, reward, or compensate any person to circulate any
- petition for any initiated measure or referendum based on the number of signatures obtained by
- the circulator on the petition. Nothing in this section prohibits any person from hiring a person
- paid on an hourly or salaried basis to circulate such petitions. A violation of this section is a
